



## How To Order Diabetes Education at McLaren Flint

- Navigate to the order entry screen and search diabetes education. Select “Referral to Diabetes Education Program”

- Immediately, a powerform will pop up. Fill out the form (yellow fields are required). Click the green checkmark in the top left of the box when complete.



**Diabetes Education Program**

Referring provider has documentation to support a diagnosis of diabetes based on one of the following (must select one)

- Fasting blood glucose greater than or equal to 126mg/dl on two different occasions
- 2 hour post glucose challenge greater than or equal to 200mg/dl on two different occasions
- Random glucose test over 200mg/dl for a person with symptoms of uncontrolled diabetes
- Gestational Diabetes: Failed Glucose Tolerance Testing

Type of training being requested

- Initial DSMES education 10 hours or specify if less
- Follow-up DSMES education 2 hours

Referral Training Options (if you chose "Individual one-on-one education" you are required to document any special needs that apply)

- Individual one-on-one education
- Medical Nutrition Therapy (MNT) 3 hours
